#### **Poster Presentation**

Intended for aspiring researchers and any Ph.D. / FPM Scholar registered with any recognised institution/university in India or other countries and in their first year.

The abstract should present a clearly defined research idea and include:

- Title
- Research problem and relevance
- Objectives
- Tentative methodology or approach

Word limit: 700-1000 words Format: PDF or Word | Font: Times New Roman, Size 12, 1.5 spacing

#### **Paper Presentation**

For advanced scholars who have Any Ph.D. / FPM Scholar registered with any recognised institution/university in India or other countries and completed at least one year of doctoral research. Submissions must be based on work that has progressed at least up to the conceptual framework stage.

The abstract should include:

- Title
- Research background and problem statement
- Objectives
- Conceptual framework
- Methodology
- Key findings or insights (if available)

Word limit: 2000-3000 words Format: PDF or Word | Font: Times New Roman, Size 12, 1.5 spacing
